Most GPS devices will get you there, make sure you see the flag on the driveway

From NJ Turnpike exit 7A: Take I-195 East to Route 526. Make a Right on Route 526 to Main Street. Make a Right on Main St. to Route 539. Make a Left on Route 539 to Arneytown-Hornerstown Road. Make a Right on Arneytown-Hornerstown Road.

From NJ Turnpike exit 7: Take Route 206 North to Route 528 (Crosswicks Road). Make a Right on Route 528; travel approximately 6 miles, Pass through 1 roundabout. and stay straight DO NOT TURN RIGHT . Stay straight to go onto Arneytown Chesterfield Rd/County Hwy-664, (Road is now Route 664). Follow Route 664; it will turn right; On the corner you note a house with windmills. Continue to follow County Hwy-664 for approximately 2 miles. Turn left onto Arneytown Hornerstown Rd. Go approximately 0.49 mile on your left. A blue flag will be in frontwith the name Upfront Dog Center.

From Freehold: Start out going southwest on W Main St/County Hwy-537 toward Throckmorton St/County Hwy-522. Continue to follow County Hwy-537. Follow Route 537 West. Turn Right on Route 539. Turn Left on Arneytown-Hornerstown Rd. Go approximately 0.49 mile on your left. A blue flag will be in front with the name Upfront Dog Center.

From Mount Holly: Follow Route 537 East. Turn Left on Route 539. Turn Left on Arneytown-Hornerstown Road. A blue flag will be in front with the name Upfront Dog Center.

****TRIAL REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS****

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$30.00 will be made for each returned check.

TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as trial closes or limits are reached. Acknowledgment of entries will include confirmation notices.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS—Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

CONSULT FINAL CONFIRMATION FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to judging. Doors will open one hour before first class is scheduled to begin.

CRATING: Indoor crating will be permitted for entered dogs only. Exhibitors must comply with designated crating areas.
