Entries can be mailed, emailed or faxed for this event. All entries and payment, regardless of method being submitted, must be received by the trial secretary prior to the closing deadline/time.

If emailing/faxing an entry after opening day, please wait for us to verify runs are available before sending PayPal payment. No point paying non-refundable fees for entries that will be closed out.

Refunds: Refunds **are** allowed if requested before the closing date . Refunds allowed after closing for Bitches in season only. There is a \$5.00 processing fee for **ALL** refunds. **No refunds for overpayments of \$10 or less.**

Bitches in season: For AKC events, Bitches in season are not eligible to participate in obedience or rally trials. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$5.00 processing fee. To receive a refund, **NOTIFICATION MUST** be given to the Trial Secretary **PRIOR TO THE START OF JUDGING** on the day in which the bitch is entered. Written verification from a veterinarian is also **REQUIRED** & must be **RECEIVED** with a copy of the dog's final confirmation. **Please scan & email these documents or send them via fax to 888-521-1706.**

A note from the Trial Secretary:

Please double check your entry forms before sending them in.

We WILL NOT process entries with the following issues:

- Unreadable hand writing
- Incomplete owner or dog information
- Incomplete class list - please list ALL classes you are entering
- Missing jump height when required for class entered

If you are unsure if your writing is legible, please ask a friend to look at it before sending in your entry. We have had a lot of difficulty deciphering handwriting.

******TRIAL REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS******

- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$30.00 will be made for each returned check.
- All judging will be indoors.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16, and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Due to judging limits, there is no guarantee that all requested transfers can be honored.
- A wait-list will be established in order to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing day.
- Obedience and Rally classes will run in jump height order from "Small to Tall" all three days.
- Your jump height must be included on the entry form for all classes that require a jump.
- Free admission / Free parking. No food vendors will be at this event.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. No smoking in the building. Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the sole discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, its members, agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

IMPORTANT EVENT INFO PLEASE READ:

- Limited indoor crating is available in the training room where the ring is, in addition to a designated area in the agility building. Dogs that are aggressive to passing dogs/people or that continuously bark or cry will not be permitted to crate inside the building. •
- **Tarps/sheets/towels** must be placed under all crates, no exceptions. The buildings will be open Friday, Saturday and Sunday at 7:30 AM. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave. Please provide your own chairs and crates. No ex-pens.
- Masks are optional at the time of this premium. This rule is subject to change at any time. Event mask rules will be listed in the final confirmations.
- **Reminder to all competitors to read their final confirmations for updated COVID rules.** We will be following the latest information and will continue to adapt our policies as needed to stay in compliance. We will not allow persons to eat inside the building. Exceptions are those eating in private offices such as office staff, Trial Chairs, Trial Secretaries, and Judges.
- Attendees should come prepared with their own food, water and other personal needs. Competitors should plan to eat outside or in their cars.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
