TRIAL OBEDIENCE ENTRY FEES:

\$36 First Entry for each dog at each trial, \$34 for each additional entry of each dog in each trial. Fees are always calculated per dog and per trial.
(Example: UDX \$70.00 per day per dog. Entering 1 class each day would be \$72)

TRIAL RALLY ENTRY FEES:

\$34 First Entry; each dog
\$30 Additional Entry Same Dog / Same Trial
Fees are always calculated per dog and per trial
(Example: RAE \$64.00 per day/per dog. Entering 1 class in each event would be \$68.)

A note from the Trial Secretary:

Please double check your entry forms before sending them in.

We WILL NOT process entries with the following issues:

- Unreadable handwriting
- Incomplete owner or dog information
- Incomplete class list - please list ALL classes you are entering
- Missing jump height when required for class entered

If you are unsure if your writing is legible, please ask a friend to look at it before sending in your entry. We have had a lot of difficulty deciphering handwriting.

Refunds: Refunds **are** allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds allowed after closing for Bitches in season only. There is a \$5.00 processing fee for **ALL** refunds. **No refunds for overpayments of \$10 or less.**

Bitches in season refunds: For AKC events, Bitches in season are not eligible to participate in obedience or rally trials. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$5.00 processing fee. To receive a refund, **NOTIFICATION MUST** be emailed to Fast Times **PRIOR TO THE START OF JUDGING** on the day in which the bitch is entered. Written verification from a veterinarian is also **REQUIRED** & must be RECEIVED with a copy of the dog's final confirmation within 48 hours after the event. **Please scan & email these documents or send them via fax to 888-521-1706.**

GENERAL SITE & TRIAL RULES/REGULATIONS

- Exhibitors are responsible for and must provide their own materials for cleaning up after their dog on the property.
- Know your armband number and scheduled show time. These will be included in your final entry confirmation.
- Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate. Ring will have a separate entrance and a separate exit.
- Rally patterns will be posted for viewing. LCCDTC recommends that exhibitors take a photo with their phone or tablet.
- **Please use the clearly marked areas for your dog's "breaks."** No other areas outside of the signed areas, nor any of the adjacent properties, may be used for elimination. **Thank you.**
- **THERE WILL BE NO CRATING OF DOGS IN THE BUILDING.**
- **ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING IN THE BUILDING**
- *Entries not on a current official AKC entry form or photocopies of the entry form without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC form will not be accepted. Entries will not be accepted without a signed waiver. A blank waiver can be found at the end of the premium.
- *Entries received without fees will not be accepted.
- *Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.
- *Returned check fee: \$30.00.
- *All PayPal fees are non refundable and are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- *No entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- *Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms, regardless of whoever made such error. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors.
- *Cancellation of entries is not allowed after the published closing date/time per AKC rules. No refunds will be issued once a trial has closed with the exception of Bitches in season (see requirements on page 5).
- *Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- *If because of riots, wars, strike, civil disturbances, National emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management to open or complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- *Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made.
- * **AKC event cancellations: call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229**
- *No wire crates on matted areas, no X-pens, and no grooming tables in the building.
- *No dogs may be left overnight in the building.
- *Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging.
- *The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called.
- *Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- *All dogs present in the building must be on leash except when in the ring being judged.

PARKING IS IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY*

No motor homes or trailers. No Overnight Parking. No generators.

LCCDTC is not responsible for damage to vehicles or loss of personal property.

Obedience fees: \$36 first run and \$34 for each additional run of the same dog in each trial.

Rally fees: \$34 first run and \$30 for each additional run of the same dog in each trial.

(example: 1 UDX entry is \$70.00 per trial. 1 RACH entry is \$94 per trial).

IMPORTANT Read Instructions on reverse side carefully before filling out. Numbers in the boxes indicate sections of the instructions relevant to the information needed in that box (PLEASE PRINT). Next, be sure to read the Agreement and sign on the reverse. No form will be processed without your signature!

Form fields: Breed, Variety, Sex, Obedience Class, Additional Obedience Class, Obedience Jump Height, Rally Class, Additional Rally Class, Rally Jump Height, Name of Junior Handler, Junior Handler Number.

Form fields: Full Name of Dog, AKC No., Foreign Reg No., Place of Birth, Date of Birth.

Form fields: Breeder, Sire, Dam.

Form fields: Actual Owner(s), Owner's Address.

Form fields: City, State/Prov, Zip/Postal Code, Country.

Form fields: Telephone #, Are you a new exhibitor?

Form fields: Email Address, Name of Agent/Handler at the Show.

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.
