

Premier Sports site rules:

Any participant who is not feeling well, please stay home!

Crating: Climate controlled Indoor Crating is allowed in designated areas. You must bring a tarp to place under your crate.

Parking: Please Park where Premier Staff directs you. Absolutely no double parking will be permitted. If you do not park within the lines, you will be asked to move. Do not park in any business neighbor's lot unless directed by Premier Staff. Vehicles not in compliance with parking rules will be towed at the owner's expense. There is limited handicapped parking, please arrive early to obtain a spot. If you need help finding a parking space, you may temporarily park in front of the building and ask for Premier Staff to help you park.

Dog Exercise Areas: Premier Sports Center has 4 acres of grass for you and your dogs to enjoy. All dogs need to be on leash and under control at all times while on Premier Sports Center premises, both indoors and outside. The only exception for off leash is when at the practice jump or in the ring. Poop bags are to be discarded in outside trash receptacles only. Do not walk your dog on our business neighbor's properties. Pay attention to your dog and pick up after your dog. Anyone seen in person or on video not picking up after their dog or walking on the neighbor's property will be subject to a bench hearing and immediate excusal from the Center for the remaining day(s) of the trial. Do not let your male dog lift its leg on the building, front landscaping, or on any item a human needs to handle.

Please be considerate of the public restrooms. Trashcans will be placed in the bathrooms for proper disposal of paper products other than toilet paper. No dogs allowed in public restrooms. Personal chairs/handicap chairs will not be allowed on the turf field. We will provide bench seating in the front of the rings for all to use. Please remove your personal belongings when your class has ended.

Smoking: Is not permitted inside our facility and not encouraged outside near others. We prefer if you must smoke that it is done inside your vehicle and that your butts are discarded in your vehicle ashtray.

Sports Center Hours: The Center will close, and doors will be locked approximately one hour after the last run has been completed for the day. Be prepared.

Hotels: The Hotel Info that we have provided on our website/premium is an extension of the trial site. Reports of barking dogs left unattended in the hotel or other behavior deemed inappropriate by the hotel management may be subject to a bench hearing. You must clean up after your dogs at the hotel. You are responsible for any damage your dog does to hotel property.

Good Sportsmanship: Please treat others with kindness and respect.

Absolutely no aggressive behavior will be tolerated by a person or dog towards another. Any person or dog who is seen acting in an aggressive manner will be asked to leave and no refund will be given and may be subject to a bench hearing. If you have an issue with a person or dog please see the Club Trial Chairman immediately. If you have an issue with the building, property, equipment, parking lot, please see a Premier Member.

Course map procedures — PLEASE READ: Per AKC rules as of 10/1/2021, course maps WILL NOT be available until the day of the trial. Course maps will be posted on site. Maps will also be posted on the Fast Times website the day of the trial before the start of the first walk-thru. Printed maps will NOT be handed out to exhibitors. Please bring a phone or tablet that you can use to access the online maps, or that can take a photo of the posted maps. Maps will be posted under the "Agility Maps" tab for all trials.

NO SETUP UNTIL Saturday morning! Site opens @ 7:00 each day.

Measuring: Measuring will be done before the trial starts and throughout the day based on judge availability.

Worker check-in: please check in with the worker coordinator 10 minutes prior to the start of the classes you will be working. See schedule for start times.

The MASCMA Challenge Cup:

MASCMA is the Miniature American Shepherd Club of the Mid Atlantic, which is a regional affiliate club of MASCUSA, the Miniature American Shepherd Club of the USA, the parent club of the breed. MASCMA's territory is New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware, West Virginia, Virginia and the District of Columbia. MASCMA is sponsoring the trophies for this event.

In addition to the flat ribbons awarded for 1st through 4th placements in each jump height each day, rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 3rd placements for Level 2 and Level 3 combined high score in each jump height each day and also for Level 1 combined high score in each jump height each day.

The MASCMA Challenge Cup trophy will be awarded for the overall winner for Level 2 and Level 3 combined each day. A separate trophy will be awarded for the overall winner for Level 1 combined each day.

To be eligible for the Level 2 and Level 3 combined rosettes and MASCMA Challenge Cup trophy each day, teams must be entered in all level 2 and 3 classes offered that day (a total of 4 classes).

To be eligible for the Level 1 combined rosettes and trophy, teams must be entered in both level 1 classes offered that day.

The winners of the combined Level 2 and 3 awards are not eligible for these prizes.

Scoring for the MASCMA Challenge Cup is as follows:

R = 3 points

S = 5 points

E = 75 points

Time Faults = 2 points for each second over time

Fix and Go is scored as an E

FEO is scored as absent (which makes you ineligible for these awards.)

Scores are cumulative and are time plus faults.

Please note: ALL times after the first walk-thru each day are approximate – **DO NOT wait and arrive close to the time listed.** We are not responsible if you show up late because you thought the class would not start until the times shown below. Refunds will not be issued if you miss your run because you arrive late. Please remember that by mid-day – the times may be as much as ¾-1 ¼ hours off. Final numbers may differ.
