There WILL be an official measurer at this trial. Exhibitor Paul Mount will be measuring dogs at this trial. If the "Will dog need to be measured?" says YES, you will need to have a valid permanent height card, valid temporary measurement slip, or you will need to be measured by a VMO. **DO NOT RISK A Q – GET MEASURED BEFORE RUNNING.** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to get their dog measured and to know the jump height card rules. AKC will check this data and you will lose a Q if you do not get measured. We have been told the AKC is cracking down on this.

Premier Sports site rules:

Any participant who is not feeling well, please stay home!

Crating info update: Climate controlled indoor crating allowed in designated areas. You must bring a tarp to place under your crate. **NO CARTS OR CHAIRS ALLOWED WHERE A CRATE CAN FIT!** Crating can get tight. Conserve space where you can. Facility personnel will move carts/chairs/crates to make space if needed.

Parking: Please Park where Premier Staff directs you. Absolutely no double parking will be permitted. If you do not park within the lines, you will be asked to move. Do not park in any business neighbor's lot unless directed by Premier Staff. Vehicles not in compliance with parking rules will be towed at the owner's expense. There is limited handicapped parking, please arrive early to obtain a spot. If you need help finding a parking space, you may temporarily park in front of the building and ask for Premier Staff to help you park.

Dog Exercise Areas: Premier Sports Center has 4 acres of grass for you and your dogs to enjoy. All dogs need to be on leash and under control at all times while on Premier Sports Center premises, both indoors and outside. The only exception for off leash is when at the practice jump or in the ring. Poop bags are to be discarded in outside trash receptacles only. Do not walk your dog on our business neighbor's properties. Pay attention to your dog and pick up after your dog. Anyone seen in person or on video not picking up after their dog or walking on the neighbor's property will be subject to a bench hearing and immediate excusal from the Center for the remaining day(s) of the trial. Do not let your male dog lift its leg on the building, front landscaping, or on any item a human needs to handle. Please be considerate of the public restrooms. Trashcans will be placed in the bathrooms for proper disposal of paper products other than toilet paper. No dogs allowed in public restrooms. Personal chairs/handicap chairs will not be allowed on the turf field. We will provide bench seating in the front of the rings for all to use. Please remove your personal belongings when your class has ended.

Smoking: Is not permitted inside our facility and not encouraged outside near others. We prefer if you must smoke that it is done inside your vehicle and that your butts are discarded in your vehicle ashtray.

Sports Center Hours: **NO SETUP UNTIL Saturday morning!** The Center doors will be open 1 hour before the start of the trial and will be locked approximately one hour after the last run has been completed each day.

Hotels: The Hotel Info that we have provided on our website/premium is an extension of the trial site. Reports of barking dogs left unattended in the hotel or other behavior deemed inappropriate by the hotel management may be subject to a bench hearing. You must clean up after your dogs at the hotel. You are responsible for any damage your dog does to hotel property.

Good Sportsmanship: Please treat others with kindness and respect.

Absolutely no aggressive behavior will be tolerated by a person or dog towards another. Any person or dog who is seen acting in an aggressive manner will be asked to leave and no refund will be given and may be subject to a bench hearing. If you have an issue with a person or dog please see the Club Trial Chairman immediately. If you have an issue with the building, property, equipment, parking lot, please see a Premier Member.

Dumpster Abuse @ Premier: Recently we are noticing more items being thrown into our dumpster. Paint materials, large plastic bins, broken dog crates etc. To empty the dumpster, we are charged by the weight and trip, and it is very expensive. Please do not use our dumpster for your personal use. Anyone caught dumping trash into our dumpster will be fined \$50.00. A camera has been added to monitor the dumpster. Thanks for your cooperation.

Course map procedures: Per AKC rules as of 10/1/2021, course maps WILL NOT be available until the day of the trial. Course maps will be posted on site. Maps will also be posted on the Fast Times website the day of the trial before the start of the first walk-thru. Printed maps will NOT be handed out to exhibitors. Please bring a phone or tablet that you can use to access the online maps, or that can take a photo of the posted maps. Maps will be posted under the "Agility Maps" tab for all trials.

Measuring: Measuring will be done before the trial starts and throughout the day based on judge & VMO availability.

Worker check-in: please check in with the worker coordinator 10 minutes prior to the start of the classes you will be working. See schedule for start times.
