## **Congratulations! You are entered in the 13<sup>th</sup> annual Westminster Masters Agility Championship being held Saturday, January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026.**

The location for this year is the Jacob Javits Convention Center 429 11th Ave, New York, NY 10001.

- Exhibitor information was emailed to everyone by Westminster & Fast Times. - There was a link included in the exhibitor guide that was emailed out that should be used to fill out the media profile for you dog/s. Here is that link in case you did not receive it directly: <https://www.westminsterkennelclub.org/online-media-profile/>
- Wristbands and parking hangtags were mailed to most exhibitors more than a week ago. Exhibitor packets for those that got moved in from the waitlist earlier this week were just mailed and should arrive soon.
- All packets should contain 2 wristbands per dog and the parking hangtag you will need to unload at the Javits Center. Please let me know after mail is delivered to you on **Friday, 1/23/26** if you have not received your packet.
- **We will be using Agility Gate again this year.** We are only using this as a live run order so it will be different than at "normal" trials. You will not be able to check in with the app or mark conflicts with the app. Everyone **MUST** check in with us upon arrival in the morning prior to setting up crating or retrieving your ProPlan shirts.
- If you requested restricted crating and were given a spot from the draw, you will need to crate that dog in the restricted crating area. You will be checked off the list when you arrive at the restricted crating area.
- If you have potential conflicts, I will be at check in. Please discuss this with me right away so we can make adjustments as needed at that time. Any changes need to be made prior to the start of the trial. Conflicts will not be allowed to be marked during the trial. If you miss your run for any reason, you will be marked absent. Be sure to see me during check in if you have multiple dogs entered in different jump heights and you think you may have an issue.
- **Be sure to pay attention to both rings during the day!** This is one way to utilize your helper!! The standard ring ran almost an hour ahead last year. We are hoping to keep things more on schedule, but it is important to be aware of how things are running so no one misses a walk through or a run.
- Please note that there have been some slight changes to the final schedule based on entry changes. The schedule in this confirmation is the way the daytime trial will run.
- **Finals tickets:** We will have approximately 130 wristbands that will allow those exhibitors access to a seat to watch the finals.
  - Those competitors who get into finals are not eligible for wristbands for seating. Finals competitors and their helpers will need to be in the staging area. There is a screen in the lounge in area 1A that is near the staging area where finalists and their helpers can view what is happening in the ring.
  - No dogs will be allowed in the seating area during the finals. No exceptions. The benches used during regular show hours will remain during the finals.
  - Wristbands will be handed out starting 20 minutes after the last run of the trial. We will set up 2 tables (location to be posted at check in) where wristbands will be distributed on a first come first served basis.
  - Exhibitors will be limited to 2 wristbands total, regardless of how many dogs you entered in the trial or how many helpers you brought with you.
  - Please be kind. We know that there will be more people wanting seats for finals than we will have wristbands for. Once we have handed out all of the wristbands, there is nothing we can do to help you stay for finals. Thank you in advance for your understanding.

**Please remember, when you arrive at the trial site you need to check-in first. We will give you a set of course maps after which you should head to the ProPlan booth to pick up your exhibitor shirt.**

**Please note: ALL the times after the first walk-thru are approximate – DO NOT wait and arrive close to the time listed.** We are not responsible if you show up late because you thought the class would not start until the times shown below. Please remember that by mid-day – the times may be as much as ¾-1 ¼ hours off. For those with conflicts, you are asked to please walk the courses with an EARLIER height group if the conflict would mean you cannot walk with your height class.

**We will have a joint briefing with both judges prior to the start of the first walk through in the standard ring.**

**Any changes to the running order must be approved prior to the start of the trial.**

**Westminster Saturday - Please note the jump height running order listed below.**

Preferred dogs will run 4" lower but in the same jump height class as their regular true jump height.

For example, the 12" preferred dogs will run with the 16" regular dogs in all rounds.

**NOTE:** Fix n Go will be allowed at this event, however, please understand that if you choose the Fix n Go option in either STD or JWW, you will receive an E in that round and will not be eligible for the Final Championship round.

**Fix n Go is not allowed in the Final Championship round.**
