## GENERAL INFORMATION

- When you arrive at the trial site, please check in and collect your course maps and a Purina Pro Plan shirt.
- The 2026 event is open to dogs with MACH and PACH titles only.
- You must have a PACH title to run in Preferred.
- The trial will be held indoors.
- Two rings on artificial turf, ring sizes 85' x 130'
- Please note that the Flyball competition is approximately 130 feet from the Agility ring, with a wall between the two halls
- There are (2) 4 ½' diameter columns in each ring

- Do not wait and arrive close to the time listed; we are not responsible if you show up late.
- Please remember that by mid-day, the times may be as much as .75 - 1.5 hours off.
- Judges' briefings will only be held at the beginning of each class, not before each jump height.
- For those with conflicts, you are asked to please walk the courses with an earlier height group if the conflict would mean you cannot walk with your height class.
- Any changes to the running order must be approved ahead of time.
- Preferred will run 4" lower but in the same jump height class as their regular true jump height.
  - For example, the 12" Preferred dogs will run with the 16" Regular dogs in all the rounds.
- Fix 'n Go will be allowed at this event. Please understand that if you choose the Fix 'n Go option in either STD or JWW, you will receive an E and not be eligible for the Final Championship round. Fix 'n Go is not allowed in Final Championship runs.

## SHUTTLE SERVICE

- WKC shuttle service will be provided to the Javits Center beginning at 5:30 AM-7:45 PM from the New Yorker Hotel at the northwest corner of 34<sup>th</sup> St and 8<sup>th</sup> Ave. and regularly throughout the day. When exiting, the buses will be located at the W. 37<sup>th</sup> St and 11<sup>th</sup> Ave entrance at the Javits Center.

## UNLOADING & LOADING

- Commencing at 6 AM Saturday, exhibitors will enter the loading dock at the Javits Center
- Security and site control personnel will be managing the overall unloading process.
- Please remember to always have your flashers on during this process and remove your vehicle promptly and safely once unloaded.
- Please display your unloading hang tag when loading and unloading at the Javits Center.
- Please have your name and cell phone on your hang tag.

## CRATING

- Upon arrival, exhibitors will be directed to the designated crating area in Hall 1C
- If you requested Restricted/Quiet crating and have been selected, you will be directed to that area
- We did add additional benches this year, but space is still limited. Please stack crates when possible, and we ask that you do not save spaces for friends
- Benches will not be assigned.
- Soft crates are permitted, but not recommended.
- Private ex-pens are not permitted in the benching area due to NYC Fire Codes.
- Also not permitted:
  - Dog tents
  - Unentered dogs
  - Agility dogs not entered in conformation are not permitted in the venue on Monday and Tuesday.

## READY RINGS

- We ask that you not remain in the ready-ring areas after your runs, as it can get very congested.
- Please be considerate of other exhibitors trying to access the rings.
- We have provided additional spectator seating this year.

## EXERCISING YOUR DOG

- There will be ex-pens provided in the loading dock area
- Grassy areas outside are limited and can be found outside the Javits Center.
- When utilizing these areas, we ask that you please clean up after your dog.
- Penalties in New York City are costly and are your responsibility.

## EXPENSES FOR TOP DOG

- The Masters Agility Champion & All-American winner will be asked to stay for a demonstration at the 150th Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show on Monday night at Madison Square Garden, as well as associated media events.
- Travel considerations will be provided to cover related expenses.

## ADMISSION TO THE EVENT

- Exhibitors will **not** have access to the facility on Friday, January 30<sup>th</sup>. Please do not visit the site on this day as there will be heavy equipment in operation, which poses a significant safety issue.
- The site will open on Saturday, January 31, 2026, at 6 AM
- Upon entering, please proceed to the Trial Secretary's table, where you will check in and receive your course maps. You will then proceed to the Pro Plan table, where you will receive your exhibitor shirt and goodie bag.
- Exhibitors will be provided with two admission wristbands per entered dog for the daytime, one for yourself and 1 for an assistant, along with your unloading hang tag. You will receive these items by regular mail. Please ensure that Fast Times has your correct mailing address. Up to 2 Finals wristbands can be obtained from the Trial Secretary on a first-come basis. There will be a limit of 130 complimentary seats available. If, after 9 AM, there are tickets remaining, additional tickets can be requested. **EXHIBITOR SEATING IS RESTRICTED TO THIS AREA ONLY. AS ALL PAID SPECTATOR SEATING HAS BEEN ACCOUNTED FOR, THIS POLICY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED BY JAVITS SECURITY!!!**

- The final round of this event will be nationally televised live on FOX. As such, Westminster encourages all exhibitors to dress in clean and presentable attire, with no bare feet, to present an appropriate image of our sport.
- Long-sleeved, black T-shirts will be provided by Purina Pro Plan for all exhibitors to wear during the preliminary rounds. These shirts can be obtained at the Purina Pro Plan booth upon check-in when entering in the morning.
- The Westminster Kennel Club will be providing purple long-sleeved Polo shirts for all finalists to wear during the Championship Round.

## LOSS OR DAMAGE

- The management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog or property of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler during the time the dog is on the show premises. See also the agreement on the reverse of the entry form.
- The welfare of an exhibitor's/spectator's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor/spectator. It is expressly understood that exhibitors/spectators will exercise control and restraint over their children while they are on the show premises.
- The Westminster Kennel Club cautions all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards that may exist, including, but not limited to: The condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should consider this a sporting event, and dress, act, and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, the site, and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By entering the show grounds, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this document and assumes all risks involved. The Westminster Kennel Club has increased the level of security planned for this year's trial. As a result, we ask that you allow a few extra minutes at check-in.
- Even with these increased measures, we strongly recommend that you do not leave valuables unattended at your setup.
