- This is an indoor facility with Sports Turf.
- Crating is allowed in the building. Please be sure to bring a tarp or mat to place under your crate.

  - Bitches in season may run at this show.

Courses will be Open level.

<b>Saturday:</b>
Team Agility
Team Jumping
Individual Jumping
Team Finals (all teams run)
<b>Sunday:</b>
Individual Agility #1
Individual Agility #2
Individual Finals

Jump heights and running order within each class with vary.

Jump heights will be based on WAO cut offs. Exhibitors may opt to run dogs in their “preferred/select” jump height. Dogs running “preferred/select” will be scored at their WAO jump height. Dog may also be entered in a higher jump height. Dogs jumping “up” will be scored in the higher jump height.

**WAO jump height cut offs are as follows:**

Dog Height at the withers	WAO Jump Height	Corresponding Preferred/Select
Dogs 12.6” and under	8”	4”
Dogs 15.0” and under	12”	8”
Dogs 17.3” and under	16”	12”
Dogs 19.7” and under	20”	16”
Dogs over 19.7”	24”	20”

\*Dog may run in any Preferred/Select height regardless of the dog’s measurement but will be scored with their WAO measured height.

**Clip and Go Agility Team Challenges Prizes:**

Prizes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> place dog in each WAO jump height in both Team Agility and Team Jumping.

**\$\$\$\$\$ TEAM FINALS CASH PRIZES \$\$\$\$\$**

A total of **\$1,020 in prize money** will be awarded in the Team Finals. Prize money will be distributed to the top three Finals teams as follows:

- 1st Place Team: \$510 (\$170 per handler)
- 2nd Place Team: \$306 (\$102 per handler)
- 3rd Place Team: \$204 (\$68 per handler)

**Clean Run Individual Competition Prizes:**

Prizes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> place dog in each WAO jump height in both Individual Agility rounds as well as Individual Jumping.

**\$\$\$\$\$ INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION CASH PRIZES \$\$\$\$\$**

A total of **\$1,000 in prize money** will be awarded proportionally across all 5 regular WAO jump heights. The split will be based on the number of dogs entered to ensure that the reward in each jump height is relative to the size of competition.

- **3 or more entries:** 1st, 2nd, and 3rd awarded
- **2 entries:** 1st and 2nd awarded
- **1 entry:** 1st place only

The prize money allocated for each jump height will be awarded as follows:

- 1st Place — 50%
- 2nd Place — 33%
- 3rd Place — 17%

In the event that a jump height does not have enough scores to award all placements, unawarded prize money will be donated to the AKC Junior Agility Team.

## The Clip and Go Team Challenge Event

- The Team Challenge Event is open to everyone – no team required!
- All exhibitors entered will run Team Agility & Team Jumping.
- Teams will consist of 3 dogs (max of 2 dogs per handler/per team). Jump heights for the dogs does not matter. They can be the same jump height or 3 different jump heights.

### Teams Format:

- This is a combined team event.
- Overall Team Results will be determined by combining scores from the three rounds (Agility, Jumping & Team Relay).
- Cumulative scoring will be time + Faults:
  - Standard Faults add 5 seconds.
  - Refusals add 5 seconds.
  - Off course/Eliminations add 150 seconds.
- Teams will run the Relay in reverse seed order.
- All three dogs must complete their section of the course or the team will earn a Relay score of 1000.

Prizes will also be awarded using standard scoring to:

- Winners in each jump height for the preliminary rounds
- Relay winner – the team the wins the relay round.

## The Clean Run Individual Competition Event

- This event consists of three preliminary rounds:
  - 2 Agility & 1 Jumping.
- Exhibitors have a chance to advance to the Individual Finals by earning a **Cup Yeah! Final's Ticket** from any of the three preliminary rounds.
- Dogs can only earn 1 **Cup Yeah!** ticket. Tickets earned by a dog that already has one will roll down to the next highest placing dog that has not yet earned a ticket.
- The number of dogs advancing to finals will be a percentage based on the number of dogs entered in each jump height.
- Dogs do not have to run in all 3 rounds to earn a spot in the finals.
- Individual prizes will be awarded in each height based on WAO cut offs in each of the three Individual classes.

### Scoring for Individual Preliminary & Final Rounds:

- All rounds in the Individual Event will be scored using standard scoring which is faults then time (clean rounds followed by rounds w/faults):
  - Standard Faults = 5
  - Refusals = 5
  - Off Course/Elimination = 150
